Professional status

SET is the professional body responsible for conferring Qualified Teacher Learning and Skills (QTLS) status and Advanced Teacher Status (ATS) to teachers and trainers in the FE and training sector, which align practitioners to ETF's Professional Standards.



What is QTLS?

It is the widely recognised badge of professionalism for practitioners in the FE and training sector. Through the six-month developmental journey, underpinned by the Professional Standards, you develop and demonstrate your teaching skills and knowledge through your practice. Being awarded QTLS signals to employers and colleagues your commitment to excellence and opens doors to broader career opportunities. It is recognised in law as equal to QTS for teaching in schools.

Your post-nominals as a QTLS holder are MSET QTLS and in order to maintain this status you must maintain your membership of SET, to be identifiable on the publicly searchable Professional Status register on the SET website.



Over 24,000 professionals have achieved QTLS since its introduction in 2008.

What is ATS?

This is the next level of progression beyond QTLS, aimed at advanced practitioners, heads of department and managers in the FE and training sector. This twelve-month programme, also underpinned by the Professional Standards, is the badge of advanced professionalism and mastery in teaching. ATS holders can demonstrate mastery, in three major competencies:

- Continuing self-improvement and development of pedagogical practice and subject specialism.
- Development of others through coaching and mentoring activity with colleagues.
- Influencing internal and external stakeholders, effecting change in curriculum and improving organisational quality.

ATS holders also achieve Chartered Teacher Status, through SET's collaboration with the Chartered College of Teaching, which is the highest accolade in teaching.
